Dear Friends,

This summer, we invite you to celebrate Flat Rock's 154th birthday by making it a better place for those at Flat Rock.

One of our 40-ton air conditioning units is quickly wearing out and, due to age and lack of availability of parts, continued repairs are not practical or cost-effective. This unit provides cooling to our nursing center, kitchen, central supply, staff/visitor restrooms, and locker rooms, training and therapy rooms, and two of our major hallways. Because of the pandemic, masks are required for all our staff. The warm air becomes uncomfortable quickly when wearing personal protective equipment. We've brought in portable air conditioners to help, but this is a temporary and inadequate "fix". Timing is less than ideal. This project is estimated to cost \$59,600 and needs to be done immediately.

Before Flat Rock, the class's monthly collection provided support to a Native American child. Upon the child's high school graduation, the program ended. Through a UMC communication, Rudy learned about the history of Flat Rock Homes and its transition to serving those with intellectual and developmental disabilities and suggested the class begin supporting this mission.

Over the years, class members have visited Flat Rock several times. Rudy recalled a moment from the initial visit, sharing they were all impressed with the employees and the visible loving care they provided to the residents. **"Truly, our hearts were touched by what we saw that day,"** said Rudy. He went on to share the stories of the residents' progress are inspiring and it is amazing to see individuals with difficulties helped so much.
